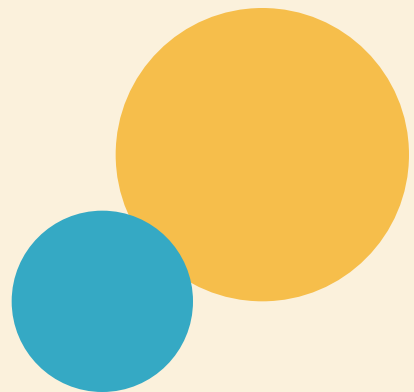

What a portfolio actually is

A portfolio is a dated, organized sample of your child's work plus a short record of what you covered. It is the easiest way to answer 'how is my child doing?' — for yourself, for family, and for any required review.

What to collect each quarter

- ☐ 3-5 math pages showing a new skill (dated).
- ☐ One writing sample, unedited, plus one revised piece.
- ☐ A reading list with dates finished.
- ☐ One photo or artifact from a science or project activity.
- ☐ Your own two-sentence note on what improved.
